

When and Where

The first Global Citizenship workshop will be held at the **University of Nottingham Malaysia Campus** from **13-14 March 2014**.

In addition, on **15 March** the University of Nottingham's Knowledge Without Borders Network will host a half-day event on the theme: *The Offshore/International Campus: Trends, Experiences, and Objectives.*

Workshop Summary

This workshop will explore our current understanding and approach towards promoting Global Citizenship within the student body. It will specifically address the question of how a global university network can develop activities that support partner organisations in enhancing student engagement with an understanding of Global Citizenship.

The workshop will use *Global Citizenship* as its central theme and will focus on the following areas:

- 1. Developing definitions of Global Citizenship, in order to better understand the potential of the term
- 2. Agreeing modes and criteria in relation to Global Citizenship, for evaluating the impact of internationalisation and mobility in the 21st century university
- 3. Exploring the integration of Global Citizenship within the contemporary, internationalised curriculum
- 4. Assessing ways in which the U21 network can facilitate positive change in curriculum, student experience and employability within Global Citizenship (speakers will facilitate discussion on these themes)
