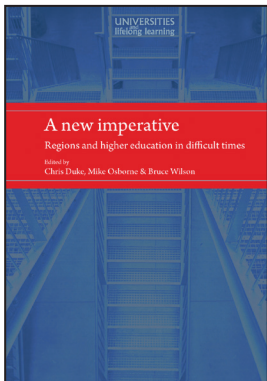
# Lifelong learning, the arts and community cultural engagement in the contemporary university
